PARENTAL CONSENT - LETTON HALL DAY TRIP 'TOGETHER': 29 OCTOBER 2020

Covid-19 prevention

As parent / guardian you send your child with the understanding that CROPS has put into place measures to reduce the risk of the spread of Covid-19 as stated in their risk assessment.

Whilst CROPS has done everything it can to reduce the risk of transmission of Covid-19, we accept that not all risk can be mitigated.

CROPS will run the day trip with Covid-19 measures in place. It is your responsibility to explain the measures to your child, and their responsibility to comply with what we ask on the day in relation to helping them stay safe and to reduce the risk of the spread of Covid-19.

By giving your consent to attend below you agree that you <u>will not</u> send your child on the day, knowing the following:

- 1. My child is feeling ill with Covid-19 symptoms*, in the previous 10 days
- 2. Someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms*, in the previous 14 days
- 3. Someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19, in the previous 14 days
- 4. My child tests positive for Covid-19, in the previous 10 days
- 5. My child is not in 'self-isolation' following contact with someone who has tested positive (outside the household) in the previous 14 days.
- 6. My child has not recently returned from travelling abroad within last 14 days.

*Covid-19 symptoms

- A high temperature – this means your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back.

- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means your child cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If your child starts with symptoms which could be COVID-19 at Letton Hall:

We will enact our plan for managing a person who starts with symptoms (supervised isolation indoors, first aid trained member of the team looking after their care, appropriate PPE provided).

We will contact you immediately to inform you and ask you to come and collect your child from Letton Hall (in line with our risk assessment). In signing the parental consent form, <u>you are agreeing that</u> <u>you will come and collect your child</u> from Letton Hall to take them home in this scenario.
