## The Bible says 'Sometimes God delivers in miraculous ways' (Daniel, 6:22-23).

Thinking about this Bible scripture, I would like you to look at the blessings Christians would say God has given you. I would like you to think about and say thank you for the people you love and the things in your life that others do not necessarily have such as a warm house, fresh water and food to eat.

To start this task, you will need a piece of A4 paper, a pencil, some writing pens and some coloured pens or pencils.

Next you need to take a moment to think about God.. I would like you to write God's name in the bark of a tree, talk to Him as you start writing God's name. Christians believe everything we have in the world comes from God, the world was created by an all powerful, all loving and all knowing God. Draw some roots under the ground to show He made the world and draw some grass to surround the base of the tree.

Now draw some long branches reaching out the top of the trunk of the tree. On these branches you will write your big blessings from God (the things you want to say thank you for). Then you can draw smaller branches growing out of the longer branches for the smaller things you are grateful for.

Finally draw your leaves and take a moment to reflect and think about the blessings and gifts God has given you.
