You may be new to sending a young person to the CROPS Letton Hall Houseparty, and therefore have questions about how things work so we have tried to answer a few things here:

TRANSPORT:

The price for Letton Hall includes coach transport there and back. Our coach departs from KingsGate Community Church at **12:30pm** on the day we depart. Please ensure that you are at KingsGate by 12:00pm latest so we can load the coach and leave on time. The coach will return to KingsGate at approximately **6:00 – 6.15pm** on the final day. Please ensure you are there at this time to collect your child. **KingsGate address:** KingsGate Community Church, 2 Staplee Way, Parnwell, Peterborough, PE1 4YT

PARENTAL CONSENT FORM

We have incorporated the permissions / parent consent (covering a wide range of things like emergency medical treatment, activities, general consent to attend etc) as part of the digital booking process on Eventbrite.

MEDICATION:

If your daughter/son has prescribed medication that they need to take whilst away, please speak to a CROPS leader when they board the coach to hand these over with any instructions. We will ensure they are appropriately and securely stored and keep a record of what and when it is administered.

PROGRAMME:
